



VESICULAR STOMATITIS MEMO

For everyone traveling to SFT for any equine events, we have consulted with Texas Animal Health Commission, veterinarians, other events and surrounding counties regarding the recent Vesicular Stomatitis outbreaks. Upon arrival, an Animal Health Inspector will be performing a visual inspection of all horses PRIOR to unloading on grounds. If horses can be visually inspected on the trailer, inspection will be done as so. If a horse is not visible while loaded, please be prepared to unload horses for visual inspection at the gate by the inspector. Current negative Coggins papers for all horses, as well as health certificates for out of state horses will still be required per TAHC regulations.

We hope everyone will continue to take additional precautions for the safety of our horses and our best attempts to prevent the spread of illnesses.

In the best interest of you as our guests, we thank you for understanding. **Please allow substantial time for the inspection upon arrival.** We will do our best to expedite this process and be respectful of your time.
